- 2 Enhance the effective engagement of NGOs for common interest in the field of transitional justice.

[OUR PROGRAMS]

HR violations documentation for survivors of torture

LDHR conducts documentation through a holistic documentation form developed by experts in forensic medicine according to Istanbul Protocol.

The documentation is being used to raise awareness and draw attention to particular abuses taking place in conflict zones, advocate for reform and ensure that survivors have access to necessary rehabilitative treatment LDHR has developed a referral and case management system to help survivors access the appropriate services.

Transitional Justice program

LDHR allocates much of its efforts to fill the gaps in the axes of transitional justice by gathering effective parties working to coordinate roundtables and distribute roles among activists and CSOs based on interest and expertise.
